





Billet Host Family Agreement

Thank you for your interest in being a host family to billeted players for the up-coming hockey season. Being a billet offers an opportunity for an individual to play hockey away from home and have a safe place to stay while doing so. We would like to thank you for your help in making this possible.

Attached are the terms and conditions of the billeting host family (herein called the host family) and the Lindsay Muskies Jr. A Hockey Club (herein called the LMHC). It is required that you agree to the terms of billeting in order to billet for the LMHC.





Terms and Conditions:

- 1. The host family is to make the player feel welcome players should not be considered tenants but as members of your household.
- 2. The host family should provide the player the address and the telephone number of the family home to carry with them.
- 3. The host family should outline the household rules that will apply to them during their stay. Outlining these rules early will help avoid misunderstanding.
- 4. During the player's stay, the host family will be required to introduce the player to the community.
- 5. The player must be provided with a clean room with basic furniture including
 - a. A comfortable bed with linens and one pillow
 - b. A dresser and closet space
- 6. The billeted player must have their own room. If an arrangement is made where there is more than one billeted player and they are in the same room, you must provide a separate bed and linens for each player.
- 7. Everyday, the host family must provide nutritious, prepared meals. The player must notify the billet if they will be missing a meal. No alcoholic beverages/drugs are to be offered to the player at any time or under any circumstances by the host family (regardless of age).
- 8. The host family must make sure that the player has a quiet environment in order to study and succeed in school, as well as quiet time to sleep and rest.
- 9. The host family must speak English with and in the presence of the player.
- 10. Under no circumstances is the host family to accept, offer, or request any favours from the players outside of day-to-day chores.
- 11. The host family is not allowed to permit the player to drive their vehicle(s) at any time.





- 12. If any physical, emotional, or verbal abuse occurs, the player will be removed from the home immediately.
- 13. Host families must have valid vehicle insurance as well as sufficient home and liability insurance in place. The LMHC reserves the right to request proof of insurance throughout the term of this agreement.
- 14. If the host family has any concerns that they cannot discuss directly with the player, please contact the LMHC as soon as possible so we may work with you to resolve your concerns.
- 15. Players under eighteen (18) must not be left at home overnight without the supervision of an adult.
- 16. Host families should not allow players to call long distance through their phone provider. Players are advised to purchase prepaid calling cards or place collect calls. The LMHC assumes no responsibility in regards to long-distance phone calls.
- 17. The host family should familiarize and permit the player access to the washer and dryer so they may do their own laundry.
- 18. The host family must provide a criminal record check (vulnerable persons level) of the adults in the home who have authority over the player.
- 19. The home must have functioning smoke and CO2 detectors on all levels of the home, and a working fire extinguisher.
- 20. All members of the family must be willing to accept and host the player. Please make sure that all members of your family are in agreement.
- 21. While the player can be invited to attend religious services, the family may not apply any pressure to do so. Respect their beliefs and culture and the player will do the same for yours.
- 22. The host family will refrain from entering into direct private arrangements (including financial agreements) with players or the player's family. To do so voids this billet agreement.
- 23. Harassment or discrimination will not be tolerated.





- 24. Any damage done to the billet property by the player is the responsibility of the player and not the LMHC.
- 25. Players are to notify their billet of their whereabouts at all times. They must include a phone number and address of where they can be reached and what time they will be returning. If the player is leaving Lindsay, they must also contact their Coach to request approval.
- 26. The host family will refrain from discussing any financial matters with the player.
- 27. The LMHC reserves the right to remove the player for any reason without notice.
- 28. Should the host family require termination of this agreement, the host family must give the LMHC prior notice.
- 29. The LMHC neither guarantees nor promises occupancy to the host family.
- 30. Players are not to have any visitors after curfew. Curfew times will be specified and followed. On a road trip, players must return to the billet home no later than 45 minutes after the team arrives at the Lindsay Recreation Complex.
- 31. The LMHC will not tolerate players who create problems for their billets.
